Select “**My Dashboard**” found on the top right-hand corner.

Select “**MANAGE MY ACCOUNT**” found on the top left-hand corner.

Select “**Request Credit**” for the event “**MGMA19 | Live.**”

In the pop up box, confirm that you did not miss more than 10 minutes in every 60 minutes of this program.

From the menu of credit types, click “**Claim Credit**” in the row(s) corresponding with your desired credit type.

**Claiming ACMPE and/or CEU Credit:**

If the Application Status column states “approved” your credit has been claimed. Click “**Download Certificate.**”

**Claiming AAPC, ACHE, CME and/or CPE Credit:**

MGMA staff will validate your attendance and license number (if applicable) within 10 business days.\*

**Claiming CNE Credit:**

MGMA staff will validate your attendance, license number and completed evaluation within 10 business days.\*

*\*If you are found ineligible to claim credit, you will be contacted by MGMA. After 10 business days, log back into the MGMA “Claim Education Credit” portal to download your certificate.*
