When billing COVID-19 vaccines, code the following:

- Vaccine CPT (only code IF vaccine was NOT distributed by government)
- Administration
- ICD-10-CM (diagnosis code) Z23 Encounter for immunization

If administering COVID-19 vaccines received from the government and not the manufacturer, do not code the CPT code for the vaccine (91300-91303). Code the administration according to dose and Z23.

Government-distributed vaccines will be free to the public. However, if medical practices order and receive vaccines directly from the manufacturer, they are billable.

Once phasing is complete, CMS indicates the allowed amounts for vaccines:

FOR VACCINES MARCH 14, 2021 AND EARLIER:

Moderna and Pfizer:	First dose	\$16.94
	Second dose	\$28.39
Janssen (J&J)	Single dose	\$28.39

FOR VACCINES ON OR AFTER MARCH 15, 2021:

Moderna and Pfizer:	First dose	\$40
	Second dose	\$40
Janssen (J&J)	Single dose	\$40

These rates will be adjusted by geographic location.
